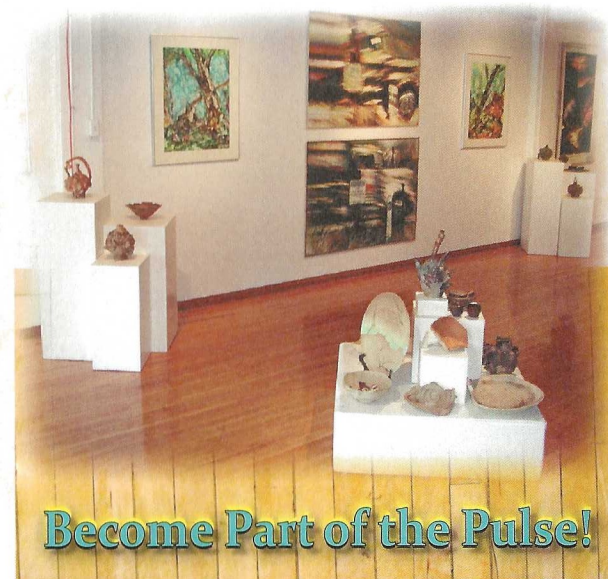

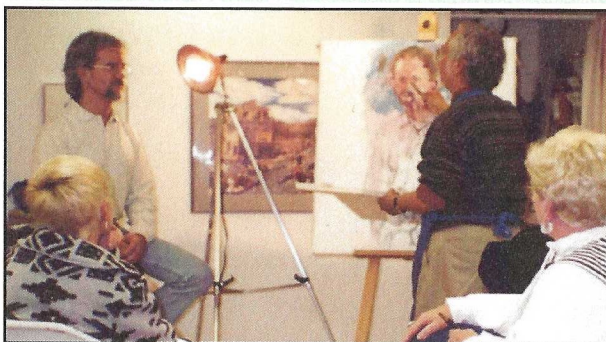

As a Member of RCAA you will enjoy:

Basic / Individual \$60

You will receive notification of all exhibits and public receptions, along with special emails on RCAA activities. Artist members can exhibit one work per member exhibit in a minimum of six member exhibits per year. \$5 hanging fee per exhibit.

Support Level \$120

Same as the Basic level, however Supporting Artist members **do not pay** any member exhibit fees.

Patron Level \$250

Same as all the above, includes a **15%** discount on purchases in the gallery. Patrons can exhibit two artworks in our member exhibits. No fees for any RCAA exhibits or events. Also includes entry to an exclusive annual show for Patrons.
